This garage has had at least two breakins this year & that was for cigarettes so having alcohol will lead to more attempts .It will attract the wrong elements to the area and increase the risk of burglary & disorder.

Sandway now has a designated 20mph speed limit as it leads onto a cycle path across the bottom of the street & more traffic could lead to more accidents. Cars are supposed to give way at the bottom for cyclists so there is a risk for them also.
