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Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives

a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d, e) (please read guidance note 10)

The applicant is aware that the premises are situated within the city centre cumulative impact zone and has sought to address the licensing objectives carefully to take this into account. Mr Hussain has 30 years of experience in the provision of food to the public and has had 15/16 restaurant/shop outlets over that time, 10 of which have had late night refreshment licenses. He is acutely aware of his responsibilities as a premises license holder and the need to ensure that there is no crime and disorder or public nuisance as a result of opening this outlet and to maintain both public safety and the protection of children from harm

He proposes the detailed measures set out below will not impact upon the cumulative effect of opening within the red light area of the City Centre CIP. He is aware that new applications in the red zone area will only be granted in exceptional circumstances.

He currently has several restaurants/takeaways in Leeds including Chicos Fast Food at 51d New Briggate, Leeds, Istanbul at 19 Merrion Street, Leeds and Nash's Fish and Chip Restaurant at 51c New Briggate Leeds Mr Hussain has always worked co-operatively with the police and licensing authority and will continue to do so with these premises

Mr Hussain intends to work from the premises. The manager will be his nephew, who has gained 5 years of experience working with Mr Hussain in the food takeaway business. He has knowledge and ability to deal with any customers who may be problematic, having held a hackney carriage license for 14 years and good links with local taxi operators and knowledge of where taxi ranks operators are, close to the premises, to assist in dispersing customers from the premises quickly after purchasing food.

Mr Hussain is fully conversant with the position of the premises in close proximity to pubs and clubs within the area. He has undertaken a risk assessment of the proposed premises in this context against the four licensing objectives.

It is noted within the Statement of Licensing Policy that Leeds population is set to rise to around one million and that the increase in city centre residential and mixed use has many benefits including the creation of a vibrant 24 hour city

Mr Hussain proposes the following -

- 1 His premises are small and will not be supplying alcohol are not alcohol led and will be run in the same style of business as at his existing premises
- 2 All staff will be expected to supply references and to agree to DBS checks
- 3 CCTV with facility to record for at least 28 days has already been installed both within and outside the premises (including the rear.) The CCTV will cover the main thoroughfare of Briggate to the front
- 4 There will be 2 door supervisors during the hours of the operating schedule one inside and one outside the premises
- 5 No bottles or glass receptacles will be used at the premises for customers rather cups or plastic containers made from recyclable material
- A full-time cleaner will be employed during the hours of the operating schedule to ensure cleanliness reduce the accumulation of debris and to deal with any spillages. At the end of each opening session the footpath/area immediately outside the premises at the front on Briggate will be washed down.

- In addition the contact details of local private hire/taxi firms will be displayed for customers
- Signs will be placed at the exit to the premises to encourage customers to be quiet until they leave the area and to respect the rights of nay local residents to sleep. Door supervisors will play a role in this.
