## The Director of Children's Services<sup>1</sup>

1. The Director of Children's Services <sup>2</sup> is authorised to discharge the following Local Choice Functions which have been assigned to full Council (see Part 3 Section 1 of the Constitution):

(a)	To make arrangements for appeals against exclusion of pupils from maintained	
	Schools	
(b)	To make arrangements for appeals regarding school admissions <sup>3</sup>	
(c)	To make arrangements for appeals by governing bodies <sup>4</sup>	

The Director of Children's Services<sup>5</sup> is authorised to discharge the following Council (non-executive) functions:

To license the employment of children	Part II of the Children and Young Persons
