Summary of main issues

This report advises Members that a temporary event notice has been received and West Yorkshire Police have served an objection notice on the grounds of public safety.

Members of the Licensing Sub Committee are asked to consider the temporary event notice and the objection notice.

1 Purpose of this report

- 1.1 To advise Members of a temporary event notice served under section 100 of the Licensing Act 2003 ("the Act") in respect of the above mentioned premises.
- 1.2 Members are required to consider this application due to the receipt of an objection notice from West Yorkshire Police.

2 History of premises

- 2.1 The applicant is currently in the process of applying for a premises licence. An objection from the Licensing Authority has been received and the hearing is also scheduled for the 27th March 2018.
- 2.2 These premises have had the benefit of temporary event notices in the past.

3 The temporary event notice

- 3.1 The proposed premises user is Mr Kyle McSparron.
- 3.2 A copy of the temporary event notice is attached at Appendix A.
- 3.3 In summary the temporary event notice is for

Sale by retail of alcohol

Saturday 7th April 20:00 until Sunday 8th April 2018 05:00.

The capacity for the event is 499 persons.

3.4 The location of the premises can be seen on the map at Appendix B.

4 Representations

- 4.1 West Yorkshire Police have received a copy of the notice.
- 4.2 West Yorkshire Police believe that allowing the premises to be used in the manner set out in the temporary event notice will undermine the public safety objective and have issued an objection notice. A copy of this can be found at Appendix C.

5 Equality and diversity implications

At the time of writing this report there were no implications for equality and diversity. Any decision taken by the Licensing Sub-Committee will be in accordance with the four licensing objectives as prescribed by the Licensing Act 2003.

6 Options Available to Members

6.1 The Licensing sub-committee must take such of the following steps as it considers appropriate to promote the licensing objectives:

- Issue a counter notice against the event in order to prevent the event from taking place.
- If the premises benefits from a premises licence, attach relevant conditions which are attached to that premises licence
- Allow the event to take place
