I have received a request to return a notice of intention with regards to a hearing for the above licensing request made by New Citizens Limited

Please accept this email as confirmation that I will not be attending the hearing nor will any representation on my behalf

I would however like to buttress my original objection with the following information

The [REDACTED] has suffered greatly in the form of petty vandalism, unauthorised access to our building noise and general antisocial behavior. My fear is that allowing licensed entertainment to take place on the residence doorstep will not only see an increase in such antisocial behavior but also potentially lead to unwanted noise for what could be up to 12 hours a day. Please note that the [REDACTED] residence is a listed building, which means that we as owners are severely limited in what we can do to combat loud noise.

I realise that the applicants rationale for the licensing application is to allow for the occasional event (approx 3 daytime events per annum). If this is the case I would ask that the applicant narrows the scope of the application to reflect such intentions.
