Dear Resident,

We are writing to update you on the work that is being undertaken to tackle high levels of reported antisocial behaviour on the Nowells estate.

Leeds City Council, West Yorkshire Police and other partner agencies are aware of this problem and are working hard to tackle the issues reported. As part of our plan to deal with this behaviour, we are consulting with you on a proposal to issue a Public Spaces Protection Order (PSPO) on the Nowells estate.

What is a Public Spaces Protection Order (PSPO)?

A PSPO is an order the local authority can make to place prohibitions or conditions on defined areas. In this case, we are seeking a PSPO on the Nowells estate with a *condition to disperse groups of 2 or more where evidence of anti-social behaviour exists.* The order will cover the following area.



Why are we seeking this PSPO?

This order is part of a range of measures being considered to deal with the anti-social behaviour on the estate. Action is being taken against those identified as perpetrators in the area. The PSPO will work in tandem with these measures to disperse people from the area that are engaging in this type of behaviour.

How will this order affect me?

This PSPO is designed to support and help residents to go about their normal daily business without fear or disruption. <u>The order will only affect those in the area engaging in anti-social behaviour</u>. Examples of this include abusive and racist behaviour, violence, arson and criminal damage. Only those engaging in this behaviour will be affected by the PSPO

Can I be involved in this process?

Before the order is made, we are consulting with residents within the area to seek your views on this proposal. The ward councillors for your area have been consulted on the proposal. You can submit your views to support or object to this order by a number of means.
