**Summary of Project:**

The Pudsey Weetwood division have been working with primary and high schools across the whole division to target school IT equipment by protecting it with Smart Water. Smart water is a DNA type liquid which is applied to IT equipment as a deterrent to theft. In the event of a theft items are harder to sell on and items that are recovered enable the police to identify exactly which location they were stolen from.

The Police have been raising awareness of community safety in schools and involving pupils in the marking of equipment.

The Police would like to further raise awareness through a poster campaign targeting primary and high schools across the division. They plan to involve all schools in a competition to design a poster. A winning primary school and a winning high school will be chosen from each area committee area.

Funding is requested to provide £200 prize money to each of the winning schools. The prize money will be used by the school to buy a piece of equipment or library books.

**£400** small grant funding is requested. (£200 for winning high school in the area and £200 for winning primary school.)

Each school would submit one poster to the School Liaison officer, who will judge the winning poster for the area. Local Councillors will be invited to take part in the judging.

Applications are also being made for the same amount of funding from Outer North West, Inner West and Outer West Committees, so the whole Division is covered. Winning Primary and High school posters will be chosen for each Area Committee area.
