Summary of main issues

This is an application to vary a premises licence held by Norman, 36 Call Lane, Leeds, LS1 6DT to specify an individual as designated premises supervisor.

1 Purpose of this report

- 1.1 To advise Members of an application made under section 37 of the Licensing Act 2003 ("the Act") to vary a premises licence in order to specify Leonna Taylor as the designated premises supervisor.

2 The application

- 2.1 The applicant's name is Mr Owen Deane Wilson.
- 2.2 The proposed designated premises supervisor is Leonna Taylor.
