I PC 5548 CATHERINE ARKLE as a Leeds District Licensing Officer for West Yorkshire Police serve notice of objection to this application

If granted, West Yorkshire Police are satisfied that the exceptional circumstances of the case would undermine the crime prevention objective, for the following reasons

- On 24th March 2019 at 03 10hrs West Yorkshire Police were alerted to largescale disorder both inside and outside Norman Bar Management and door staff had lost control and violent disorder was taking place This was less than 2 weeks after the application to vary the DPS was submitted – received by the Licensing Authority on 14th March 2019
- The premises are now subject to a summary review application submitted by West Yorkshire Police due to serious crime and serious disorder at the premises

Therefore, West Yorkshire Police would ask any presiding sub-committee at a hearing, to refuse this application outright with a view to promoting the crime prevention objective

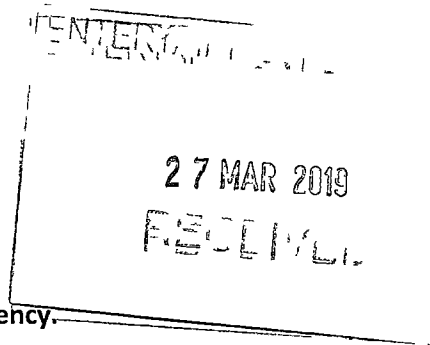
