# Entitlement to work/immigration status for individual applicants and applications from partnerships which are not limited liability partnerships

A licence may not be held by an individual or an individual in a partnership who is resident in the UK who

- does not have the right to live and work in the UK, or
- is subject to a condition preventing him or her from doing work relating to the carrying on of a licensable activity

Any premises licence issued in respect of an application made on or after 6 April 2017 will become invalid if the holder ceases to be entitled to work in the UK

  who is a family member of such a national or who has derivative rights of residence in exercising treaty rights in
  the UK including -
  - evidence of the applicant's own identity such as a passport,
  - evidence of their relationship with the European Economic Area family member e.g. a marriage certificate, civil partnership certificate or birth certificate, and
  - evidence that the European Economic Area national has a right of permanent residence in the UK or is one of the following if they have been in the UK for more than 3 months
    - (i) working e g employment contract, wage slips, letter from the employer,
    - (ii) self-employed e.g. contracts, invoices, or audited accounts with a bank,
    - (III) studying e.g. letter from the school, college or university and evidence of sufficient funds or
    - (iv) self-sufficient e g bank statements

Family members of European Economic Area nationals who are studying or financially independent must also provide evidence that the European Economic Area national and any family members hold comprehensive sickness insurance in the UK. This can include a private medical insurance policy, an EHIC card or an S1, S2 or S3 form

- (II) any page containing the holder's photograph,

Your right to work will be checked as part of your licensing application and this could involve us checking your immigration status with the Home Office. We may otherwise share information with the Home Office. Your licence application will not be determined until you have complied with this guidance.

## Home Office online right to work checking service

As an alternative to providing a copy of the documents listed above, applicants may demonstrate their right to work by allowing the licensing authority to carry out a check with the Home Office online right to work checking service
