1. 1 Purpose of this report

- 1.1 To approve an appointment to a vacancy which has arisen on the West Yorkshire Combined Authority Transport Committee, a meeting of which is to be held during the period between the Local Elections (2nd May 2019) and the Annual Council Meeting (22nd May 2019), in consultation with the relevant Political Group Lead, in order to ensure that the meeting can proceed with adequate and appropriate membership levels.

2 Background information

- 2.1 The City Solicitor's Officer Delegation Scheme authorises her to appoint to vacancies on Committees, Boards and Panels held during the period between the Local Elections and the Annual Council Meeting, in consultation with the relevant Group Whips, in order to ensure that meetings held during that period can proceed with adequate and appropriate membership levels.
- 2.2 The City Solicitor has sub-delegated this responsibility to the Head of Governance & Scrutiny Support.

3 Main issues

- 3.1 Following the Local Elections held on 2nd May 2019 a vacancy has arisen on the West Yorkshire Combined Authority Transport Committee which is scheduled to meet during the period between those Elections and the Annual Council Meeting on 22nd May 2019.
- 3.2 In order to ensure that this meeting can proceed with adequate and appropriate membership levels, and following consultation with the relevant Political Group Lead, it is proposed that the following Councillor be appointed for the duration of the period leading up to the Annual Council meeting:-

- **Councillor Garthwaite to replace Councillor Lyons on the West Yorkshire Combined Authority Transport Committee.**

- 4.1.1 The nomination for the appointment has been identified in consultation with the relevant Political Group Lead via the Group Manager.
