

Notice of formal Objection

Licensing Act 2003

Tens Received on the 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2019 for Licensed Activities at The Engine, Moor Road, Leeds, LS10 2JJ

We have recently received notification of a Temporary event for the 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> June 2019. This notification is for an event to extend their permitted hours for the sale of alcohol, regulated entertainment and late night refreshment from 1am to 4am.

The premises are a public house with a flat above and are located in a mixed use area with other residential properties in close proximity. Since June 2018 we have received complaints regarding loud music from 5 different complainants with the most recent having been received on the 8<sup>th</sup> May complaining about loud music starting during the day on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> May and going on until 3:30am Monday 6<sup>th</sup> May 2019. They also allege that this happens most weekends and that their complaints of loud music only started from these premises with a recent change in management.

The latest complaint has arisen despite this department sending the applicant 3 warning letters regarding the TENs they had applied for received in April 2019. We also objected to the last TEN that was submitted for the 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> May. As this was a late TEN, the event was not allowed to go ahead.

This Department therefore has concerns that the licensing objective for the prevention of public nuisance will not be met should this proposed event take place and thus is formally serving notice that we object to this TEN application.
