    of Greco-Roman wrestling, or freestyle wrestling between 08 00 and 23 00 on any day

    - a performance of amplified live music between 08 00 and 23 00 on any day in a workplace that is not licensed to self alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500
    - a performance of amplified live music between 08 00 and 23 00 on any day in a church hall village hall community hall or other similar community premises that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500 and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises
