Dear Julian,

I email you with regards to the subject premises / application.

West Yorkshire Police have no outright objections with regards to the application, but would however ask the applicant to consider agreeing to a couple of measures / conditions, one as alternative wording to what has already been offered, and the other additional, namely-

- 1. CCTV the alternative wording below is taken from an official document of the licensing authority Leeds City Council, and shared between all the responsible authorities in Leeds, and
- 2. Challenge 21 or 25 the licence will have in any event attached to it, a 'mandatory condition' in relation to an age verification policy, however, the additional wording below is common with licensed operators in Leeds as an extra 'safeguard', and is again taken from the same official document referred to above.

The actual wording for both the above to read-CCTV-

- A suitable closed circuit Television (CCTV) system will be in operation at the premises at all times when it is being used for the provision of licensable activities and/or when members of the public are permitted to be on the premises.
- The CCTV system will record images to cover all areas of the premises to which the public have access (save for toilets), including any external areas of the premises such as car parks and beer gardens.
- The CCTV system will be capable of retaining images for a minimum of 31 days, will be of good quality and will contain the correct time and date stamp information.
- The CCTV system and images will be kept in a secure environment to which members of the public will not be permitted access.
- At least one member of staff will be on duty at the premises who is capable of operating the system and downloading images recorded by it. These images will downloaded and provided, on request, to an officer of a responsible authority.

Challenge 21 or 25-

The age verification policy adopted by the premises, in respect of the sale or supply of alcohol will be Challenge 21 (or 25), which means that those seeking to purchase alcohol at the premises who appear to be under the age of 21 (or 25) will be required to provide acceptable evidence (as approved by West Yorkshire Police) that they are 18 years of age (or older) before any alcohol is sold or supplied to them.

I look forward to your reply and agreement hopefully in due course, but preferably before the end of business tomorrow, which is the cut off day for making representations.
