

**Explanation:** Costs have doubled since the original approval, and BHS submitted evidence to a recent public inquiry which showed that the scheme will not operate as intended at Wyther Lane. This would cause congestion in Armley and Bramley and attempts to solve this problem could cause difficulties elsewhere. The proposals will interact with the A65 Quality Bus Initiative and could affect the financial viability of the affordable housing scheme at the Kirkstall District Centre. The original policy decision should be reviewed and any other options examined for this complex road network.
