

Proposed Conditions



- 1 The premises will operate as an adventure golf course
- 2 The premises licence holder shall install and maintain a comprehensive CCTV system at the premises which covers,
 - all entry and exit points to and from the premises enabling frontal identification of every person entering under any light conditions
 - the areas of the premises to which the public have access (excluding toilets)
- 3 The CCTV system shall continually record whilst the venue is open for licensable activities and during all times when customers remain on the premises. All recordings shall be stored for a minimum period of 31 days with date and time visible. Recordings shall be immediately arranged by a member of staff for handover to the Police or an authorised officer following their request.
- 4 A staff member from the premises who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be on the premises at all times when the premises are open to the public. This staff member shall be able to arrange for Police to view recent data or footage with the absolute minimum of delay when requested.
- 5 All staff whose duties include alcohol sales will receive training regarding their responsibilities and obligations under Licensing Act 2003. Training will be documented with copies being made available to officers of the responsible authorities on request.
- 6 No customer under the age of 18 shall be allowed into the premises.
- 7 A Challenge 25 scheme will be operated. Customers who appear to be under 25 years of age will be required to prove their age upon entry to the premises. Suitable forms of identification will be a passport, photocard.

driving licence, military identification or any other government approved proof of age document bearing the PASS hologram

- 8 The DPS will risk assess the need for door supervision SIA registered door supervisors will be provided on such dates, in such numbers, and between such times as required by the risk assessment
- 9 Customers will not be permitted to take drinks outside save for to any designated outside drinking area shown on the plan attached to the premises licence
- 10 An incident log book shall be kept on the premises and made available on request to the Police The incident book will record the following
 - I Any incidents of crime/disorder
 - II Any seizures of drugs or offensive weapons
 - III Any ejections of patrons
- 11 A refusals book/log will be operated and made available for inspection upon request by the police/responsible authorities
- 12 The hire of golf clubs and use of the Ghetto Golf area will be documented with the name, address and contact number of each customer being recorded
- 13 The premises will operate a zero tolerance to policy to drugs and signage to this effect will be displayed by the toilets
- 14 Polycarbonate or plastic drinking vessels will be supplied to any customer drinking within the golf area
- 15 Signage will be displayed at the exit of the premises asking customers to leave quietly
- 16 All regulated entertainment provided will be inaudible at the boundary of the nearest residential properties

17 All external windows or doors will remain closed during regulated entertainment save to permit access & egress
