	A brief statement of the reasons for the decision ³ As part of the emergency planning in response to the Covid-19 outbreak, the City Council is making preparations for the provision of a temporary mortuary to support existing facilities in the city. Separately, the Director of Communities and Environment has been requested to approve the Waiving of Contract Procedure Rules 9.1 and 9.2 to authorise the appointment of Airedale Catering Equipment Ltd to supply and install bespoke equipment into the proposed temporary mortuary without inviting competitive tenders for such equipment. The Chief Finance Officer has confirmed support for the payment of a deposit of 35% of the contract value of each order placed with the company
