	 In 2018/19 a successful bid was made to MHCLG's Rough Sleeper Initiative (RSI) for two workers to support people who are, or are at risk of, rough sleeping and / or begging to access accommodation. One would take the role of an assertive outreach worker, the second provided in-reach in hospitals and prisons. The workers was placed within Change Grow Live (CGL) which already delivered the city's Street Outreach Team. MHCLG have agreed to continue this activity in 2020/21 in recognition of the work that Leeds is doing to tackle rough sleeping and begging, with an increase in the number of posts to four in order to meet demand. As such there will now be: 2 x assertive outreach workers (including one with additional language skills to better engage with EEA clients)
