	The Leeds Homes Choice Based Lettings Scheme was suspended on 23 rd		
	March following guidance from central government around social distancing		
	due to the COVID19 crisis. This has meant that people with an assessed		
	housing need, and a priority to reflect that, have been unable to bid.		
	Currently, priorities last 180 days after which the customer needs to make		
	contact to extend it. The officer considering the priority extension will look at		
	whether the customer has been bidding regularly and appropriately to reflect		
	the urgency of their housing need.		
	Therefore, the decision has been made to extend everyone's priority for a		
	further six months for three reasons:
