Given the changes proposed, we have carefully considered the application, the effect on the licensing objectives and the Council's Licensing Policy. The purpose for seeking later hours for the sale of alcohol and live music would allow our customers to continue their night in a safe and comfortable environment and allowing more flexibility around trading. The experience from our existing customers shows that at the moment when people leave they head to other premises, rather than going home.

The application also seeks to extend the terminal hour for late night refreshment until the terminal hour for the sale of alcohol to allow the premises to sell hot drinks to their customers during these times.

The new non-standard timing for all licensable activities on New Year's Eve is already permitted for the sale of alcohol at embedded restriction 9.

- 1. The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive CCTV system
- Customers will not be permitted to remove from the premises any drinks supplied by the premises in open containers unless to an external drinking area set aside for consumption
