	The Best Council Plan 2020 to 2025, sets out the Council's ambition for Leeds to have a strong economy and to be a compassionate city, tackling poverty and reducing inequalities. Supporting residents into learning and work is an important contributor to this ambition			
	On 23 July 2020, the Council received confirmation of the annual funding allocation of £2.2 million from the Education and Skills Funding Agency (ESFA) under the Adult Education Budget (AEB), for the delivery of Adult Learning in the academic year 2020/21 from 1 August 2020 to 31 July 2021. The terms and conditions of funding were accepted on 30 July 2020.			
	This decision is to award up to £1.6m of the ESFA AEB funding for academic year 2020/21 to 15 successful biders to ensure the Adult Learning programme delivers according to Council priorities and a broad and balanced programme of Adult Learning across the City, specifically targeting residents living in the 20% most deprived neighbourhoods on the Indices of Multiple Deprivation.			
	This decision includes allocating £10k of funding and a two year contract award for continued hosting, maintenance and updates to the Leeds Adult Course Finder and the Employment and Skills websites.			
	Due to the annual recurring nature of this adult education funding the required programme managers, quality officers, tutors and administrative resources are already in post for delivery in academic year 2020/21.
