Dear Sirs,

I wish to expand on my recent objections in relation to the above premise licence application -

My husband is a [REDACTED] in Leeds and works shifts. Sleep is very important to him and he has been kept awake by the noise of many cars parking in the street, car doors slamming and customers shouting. The noise persists into the early hours and is worse at weekends. We have no option but to keep all our windows closed but the noise still prevents sleep.

Customers have parked on the verges in adjacent Upland Road which have been churned up and heavily littered. Infact the verges are so churned up and devoid of soil that some cars are catching their sills on the kerbs. The litter includes nitrous oxide cylinders (laughing gas - that people take to get high) - in such large quantities that I can fill a bag every day.

There have been large numbers gathering outside the premises during lockdown with no social distancing. Something that has especially concerned my husband and the issues we have experienced have been reported to the police but no interest has been shown, telling us its a licencing issue

Cars have parked revving engines and been raced up and down Easterly Road and Roundhay Road into the early hours of the morning.

I have also seen people bringing trays of food from their cars.

Regarding our privacy, I do not wish our name and address to be revealed to the Applicants as I fear reprisals. I am a [REDACTED] in Leeds so value my anonymity perhaps more than some. We live a few houses away from the premises.
