	A procurement exercise was commenced 25th November 2020 after obtaining		
	the authority to undertake a procurement as a Key Decision via the Special Urgency Provisions (reference D5250). The invitation to tender closed 2nd		
	December 2020 and following evaluation has resulted in 31 additional beds		
	across 6 care homes being identified.		
	All ensuing costs generated by calling off from the framework will be fully		
	funded from the discharge to assess funding from the NHS Leeds Clinical		
	Commissioning Group.		
	Brief details of any alternative options considered and rejected by the decision maker at the time of making the decision		
	The precedent for the decision set out here was created during the first period		
	of the pandemic and the subsequent procurement of an intial D2A framework		
	agreement for the city which was established from the 1st November 2020,		
	whereby spare capacity within care homes was sought to minimise the impact		
	of COVID-19 on the health and social care system. This decision is looking to		
	build upon that existing solution.
