Dear Sirs,

I would like to formally object to the above PREM/04367/01 from Morrison's Morley.

There are no other premises in Morley Town Centre with such a licence as Morrison's are asking for.

Along Queensway opposite the Petrol Station there is a Skate Park within Scatcherd Park.

Leeds City Council have a Youth Bus positioned nearby during the evenings offering help and advice to young people.

We understand that youngsters under age are asking older young people to buy drinks for them.

Our Local Neighbourhood Policing Team need to be asked for their views on this application. Anti Social Behaviour is a long standing problem here.

COVID restrictions of 10.00 p.m. closing will draw customers in to buy alcohol to allow people to carry on drinking after the pubs close.

To sell alcohol until 5 a.m. is uncalled for we have as I have pointed out Anti Social Behaviour in this area on an evening.

Morley Town Centre has a number of Sheltered Housing complexes with Schofield Court almost next door and Queens Court on Queen Street. Kirkness Court on Corporation Street and Jubilee Court on Marshall Street selling alcohol until 5.00 a.m. would most certainly cause trouble for these elderly residents.

I am absolutely against this application please accept my points above.

Dear Sirs

Application PREM/04367/01

I would like to formally submit an objection for the above application for Morrisons to sell alcohol at their petrol station situated in the town centre.

I am extremely concerned as to the hours needed to sell alcohol. There are no other premises in the town centre with a license that Morrisons are asking for.

Opposite the garage is the skate park for young people situated next to the sports centre within Scatchard Park.

Leeds City Council's Youth Services position their Youth bus during the evenings offering help and advice to any youngsters needing anyone to talk to.

This is often blighted by teenagers drinking alcohol. It has been witnessed that younger children are asking older people who are old enough to be served, to buy their alcohol for them.

I would advise licensing to speak to our local Neighbourhood policing team for their views on this application as they are the ones who receive the complaints from residents who witness anti social behaviour.

With the present situation of Covid and pubs closing at 10.00pm, for the visible future, would encourage people to buy their alcohol at the garage.

To have the license to 5.00am is ridiculous and unnecessary and will attract young people to an area where anti social behaviour is already causing concerns for the police and the general public.

Also, next door to the garage is Schofield Court, a sheltered housing complex, which our elderly people live and do not need late night antics due to alcohol being sold till early hours.

I feel I can't support this application.
