Inner West Covid-19 Cases – Update

Purpose of report

1. To provide the Inner West Community Committee with an update on Inner West Covid-19 cases.

Main issues

2. Community Committee Members have requested a discussion regarding the number of positive cases of Covid-19 in the Inner West area. The Armley and Bramley & Stanningley wards have had some of the highest positive case rates across Leeds.
3. Between the 18th February 2021 and the 24th February 2021, the Armley ward had 240.6 positive cases per 100,000 and Bramley & Stanningley had 180.4 per 100,000. It should be noted, that the figures are changing every week, therefore, up to date figures will be brought to the meeting on 16th March 2021.
4. Members are keen to understand how the Community Committee and local residents can work together to combat the challenges around Covid-19 positivity cases.

Recommendations

5. To note the contents of the briefing note and receive the update from Public Health.
