	2 Year old funding-The 2 year old FEEE funding rate paid to Leeds City	
	Council (the LA) by the DfE has increased from £5.28 to £5.36 for each eligible	
	hour of entitlement and that this is to be passed on directly to providers as their hourly rate for 2 year olds.	
	3 and 4 Year Old funding - The 3 and 4 year old FEEE funding rate paid to	
	Leeds City Council by the DfE has increased from £4.89 per eligible hour to
