31/03/2021. A further modification will run for the period of 9-months from 01/04/2021 to 31/12/2021. There are no further opportunities to extend or modify this Framework Agreement.

The provision under the Public Contract Regulation 72(1) sets out the conditions required to allow the extension or modification of an existing contract can take place without a new procurement procedure.

The requirement for the modification to the Leeds Interim Framework Agreement has been brought about by circumstances which the local authority could not have foreseen, COVID-19; this does not change the overall nature of the framework; to deliver quality placements for our children looked after and care leavers (16-25 years).

The increase in price does not exceed 50% of the value of the original contract.

## A brief statement of the reasons for the decision

The requirement for the modification to the Leeds Interim Framework Agreement has been brought about by circumstances which the local authority could not have foreseen – COVID-19.

COVID-19 has impacted on the number of properties being available for vulnerable young people who are ready to transfer to full independence to move on to accommodation outside of our commissioned services - no movement out has affected the number of available accommodation units for new placements to move in to. A further critical point is that COVID-19 also impacted Leeds City Council – Choice Based Lettings (CBL) scheme; reduced availability of move on options for those young people currently in service has caused a bottleneck. In turn, this presents a risk to the local authority, in its statutory duty to ensure that children looked after and care leavers are placed in suitable support and accommodation placements, , within an unregulated market, post the end of the Leeds Interim Framework Agreement, 31/03/2021.

This modification will be a further interim position and support Leeds City Council to identify placements within the constraints of an agreed
