Since 31st May 2021 the Inner East Community Committee Facebook page has gained **9 new page likes** putting the total 'likes' at 1,100 and currently has **1,372 followers** (an increase of 103 since the last committee meeting).

This means that this is the **second** most popular Community Committee page in the last 28 days.

There are two things to note in general:

- 'reach' is the number of people the post was delivered to
- 'engagement' is the number of reactions, comments or shares

Engagement tends to be a better way of gauging if people are interested and have read the posts because they wouldn't have interacted with it otherwise. For example, a post might reach 1,000 people but if they all scroll past and don't read it, the engagement is 0 and it hasn't been an effective way for the Community Committee to communicate.

Having said that, all posts can be read without any further interaction!!

The following below are screenshots of the most popular three posts since the 31st May 2021. Alongside it are the figures for how many people were 'reached' and how many people 'engaged' with the post.

1st Place – The Vinery Centre “Speakeasy” course

2nd Place – Vaccination Bus at Nowell Mount


