Kamala Food & Wine 430 Leeds & Bradford Road PREM/00933/003

All three Bramley and Stanningley Councillors wish to object to the application from Kamala Food & Wine 430 Leeds & Bradford Road to extend hours of opening and hours for sales of alcohol.

The objection is based on the licensing objective: Prevention of Public Nuisance.

The current premises opening hours are

**Monday to Saturday**    **08:00 – 23:00**

**Sunday**                    **10:00 – 22:30**

With

**Sale by retail of alcohol :-**

**Monday to Saturday**    **08:00 – 21:00**

**Sunday**                    **10:00 – 21:00**

The premises opening hours are already being breached, having witnessed them open for sales from 06:30 -11pm daily. Whilst goods have been traded within those hours we have no direct evidence alcohol sales have taken place beyond the current hours.

#### **Prevention of Public Nuisance**

We believe the proposed opening hours will lead to noise nuisance particularly affecting the adjoining neighbours in a residential area. Most visits will inevitably be by vehicle and the potential for noise

nuisance from car doors opening and closing, conversation to and from the premises, as well as the entry/exit to the premises, is unacceptable on a 24 hour basis.

In addition, there will likely be an increase in vehicle movement through the delivery of telephone orders throughout the night.

There is already evidence of poor litter management on the forecourt of the premises with local volunteer litter pickers being left to tidy the area on a regular basis. Longer opening hours will only exacerbate this.

The application states that the shop will be locked between the hours of 12.00 midnight and 5.00am, with access via ringing a bell. We believe this will add further potential for noise nuisance through the sound of a doorbell and the meeting, greeting etc that results from this type of entry.

A more acceptable application to regularise and approve their current actual opening hours, including permission for sales of alcohol within those hours would be considered acceptable on a trial basis of 12 months. If during this 12 month period all 4 licencing objectives continued to be met, we would have no objections to it becoming permanent subject to continuing good practice.

Good morning,

I would like to submit an objection to the above planning application from Kamala Food & Wine, 430 Leeds & Bradford Road, to extend their hours of opening and hours for sales of alcohol, based on the prevention of Public Nuisance.

The premises are seeking to change their current opening hours, of 8am to 11pm Monday to Saturday, and 10am to 10.30pm on Sundays, and their current sale of alcohol by retail hours, of 8am to 9pm Monday to Saturday, and 10am to 9pm on Sundays, to 24 hour opening hours during which the sale of alcohol for consumption off the premises would be permitted throughout.

I understand that the premises□ current opening hours have already been breached, with witnesses describing seeing them open for sales from 6:30am until 11pm daily, which indicates a disrespect for planning restrictions and regulations.

In addition, the proposed changes to these opening hours will increase noise nuisance in the area, particularly for the adjoining neighbours, as the shop is based in a residential area. It is likely that a majority of visits will be by vehicle, which will create additional noise nuisance from car doors opening and closing, as well as customers entering and exiting the premises, and having conversations as they do so. It would be unacceptable for residents to experience this additional noise nuisance on a 24 hours basis. I understand that there is ongoing evidence of poor litter management outside of the premises with local volunteer litter pickers being left to tidy the area on a regular basis. Longer opening hours will only exacerbate this.

I would be very grateful if this objection could be considered as part of the planning application.

We would like to put forward my objection to the licensing application for extended opening hours and hours for sale of alcohol at Kamala Food and Wine at 430 Leeds and Bradford Road (PREM/00933/003)

We have been local residents for nearly 10 years and find the location to be largely quiet at night with no trouble.

We are seriously concerned at the potential for increased traffic (both on foot and vehicle), the slamming of car doors, noise disturbances from those purchasing goods/alcohol and just a general increase in noise at typically peaceful times.

We already experience significant issues with dropped litter in spite of a litter bin outside the shop which is left to be cleared up by residents and local volunteer groups. There are also times where large groups of young people congregate outside the shop and I feel extending the opening hours will exacerbate this issue. In addition to these issues many people already visit this shop in their cars and block out driveways as there is not sufficient parking, late night customers are more likely to be visiting by car and causing obstructions.

I understand that there is an application to extend licencing hours at the shop at the bottom of my street namely

Kamala Food & Wine 430 Leeds & Bradford Road PREM/00933/003

I would like to object to this application. It seems this is not the wisest location to have a shop effectively open 24/7 at. Late at night the passing cars will not be expecting the disruption that parking, turning and taxis coming and going will cause. For the cars stopping there will just be more traffic. Whilst I am unlikely to be affected by the slamming of car doors and conversations negotiating what is being purchased there are plenty people nearer who will. This is a surprisingly quiet location other than through traffic and having lived next to a 60mph main road as a child I know you get familiar with moving car noise but having then moved to the heart of Leeds 6 I know too well how hard it is to cope with the intrusion of door slams and voices □ especially if anyone is not of a mind to moderate the tone and volume - this is very disruptive. I would therefore anticipate a large scale moving out from the 50 or so most local houses to the shop □ when we finally start working in offices again that□s going to have a knock on for my public transport experience as the shop is right between 2 busy Bramley-Leeds centre bus stops. I sure I□m not alone in that I don□t really want to be avoiding litter and rubbish and fresh vomit that goes hand in hand with such shops on Armley Town street at 7.45 in the morning □ or worse, 6pm on a dark evening on the way home from work. I therefore object on the grounds of impact to a suburban community that is trying to support having a friendly integrated community.

There is a traffic travelling up and down Newlay Lane between Leeds Bradford road and broad lane 24/7. As this is the most direct route from Town street to this store if it gains a reputation as being the closed all night off licence for those living in Armley, and Bramley and pretty much anywhere closer than the Owlcoates ASDA in West leeds then this is going to become significantly more of an issue if this licence is permitted, which is my personal grounds for objection. This would mean that I either give up sleeping, give up sleeping at nights or move house for at least that period of the year where it is reasonable to sleep with a bedroom window open. I am not sure that is reasonable. Of course those walking from Bramley town

end to shop late at night are even more disruptive as they are likely to already be inebriated □ I know neighbours have told me of people who may or may not be intoxicated (but appear to be) visible on some of the streets CCTV acting in unneighbourly ways - stressing out the local cat population and I suspect being the cause of some of the alterations to garden furniture and extra wet patches on hedges, and as I live at the point the hill suddenly flattens the volume and nature of conversation often intrudes if it□s an unexpected burst.

I know there are already issues on Pollard lane with kids who probably can□t purchase their alcohol in pubs yet and don□t understand the impact of their actions periodically putting stones, wood, fencing or other items in the road near the old quarry causing damage to those driving to the Horsford estate. Another source of alcohol is unlikely to positively contribute to that situation. [REDACTED] I□d like to join in solidarity with those affected and ask that you ensure that the effort to get intoxicated in this part of the woods is maintained at its current level so this doesn□t get worse.

I can□t impose my values on others much as I□d love to, I have no right to ask the law to cast judgement on others. But the purpose of licencing laws are to encourage people to live in a moderately organised way, that doesn□t impinge on the majority of people□s ability to make a positive contribution to a cohesive society. It seems to me that if someone is so disorganised they fail to purchase an appropriate amount of alcohol to drink between the time pubs shut and breakfast places open before pub closing time within the community they live they may need to reflect on how they are helping their community be a kind and compassionate environment to be in. Please do not extend the opening hours and please ensure that the current licence hours are enforces
