Decision	 What decision has been taken? The Chief Officer (Highways & Transportation): a) agreed to withdraw the Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (TTRO) at Beecroft Primary School (signage was bagged over October half term and those affected were informed. The signage will need to be removed). b) agreed not to pursue a permanent TRO at Cross Gates Primary School after the expiry of the TTRO one on 1st December 2021, remove School Street signage and inform those affected that this scheme will not be made permanent. c) agreed to replace the TTROs with TROs at the remaining Phase 1 School Street sites, noting amendments to wording, timings and location of signs as set out in Appendix 3. d) agreed to amend the extent of the School Street at Ingram Road Primary School to that which has been used during the trial. See plan Appendix 4. e) agreed to authorise the City Solicitor to proceed with the above regarding the TTROs and TROs as required, including advertising the same and, if no valid objections are received, to make, seal and implement the Orders as advertised: and f) noted that following the full evaluation of the School Street sites in Leeds will be made to this Board.

	A brief statement of the reasons for the decision		
	 School Streets Trials were implemented in Leeds in two Phases by Temporary Traffic Regulation Orders (TTROs), six from the 1st June 2020 and a further eight from 5th September 2020. Feedback has been monitored throughout the trial and an evaluation involving surveys of staff, families and residents, traffic data surveys and interviews with delivery partners has been taking place since June 2021. The TTRO for Phase 1 School Streets expired on 1st December 2020 so a decision about the future of these initiatives is needed in sufficient time to make any permanent TROs required for the continuation of the schemes. Five of the Phase 1 trials have had a positive impact and are working relatively well, as intended so are being made by permanent TRO. 		
	Issues at one of the Phase 1 School Streets have not been resolved and as such a decision has been taken to allow the TTRO to expire in December and the restrictions be removed.		
	One of the Phase 2 School Street Trials has required a much higher level of intervention and has experienced more issues than others so a decision has been taken to suspend it from the trial early over the October half term.		
	Brief details of any alternative options considered and rejected by the decision maker at the time of making the decision		
	The alternative proposal of not making any of the Phase 1 School Streets permanent and letting the Temporary Traffic Regulation Orders (TTROs) expire would send a negative message to residents in Leeds and nationally about the efficacy of School Streets as an initiative for supporting safe, sustainable and healthy travel to schools.
