Hello,

I previously put forward a qualified objection to PREM/04883/001, owing to concerns about noise nuisance affecting nearby noise sensitive premises, and suggested additional license conditions to address this. I have been liaising with the applicant's agent, Paddy Whur, and have agreed that Environmental Health would have no objection to the license application providing the following conditions are added, worded as such:

1. Any external speakers will not be used after 2200.
2. The premises licence holder / designated premises supervisor will ensure that patrons use the external roof terrace in a manner which does not cause disturbance to nearby residents and businesses in the vicinity. The area will be cleared and closed to customers from 2300 each day.
3. The designated premises supervisor, and any door supervisors, will monitor the activity of persons leaving the premises and remind them of their public responsibilities where necessary.
