Hi,

There is a notice for an alcohol licence application in my local area, I have attached a picture of it. I can't find any application under this address on the planning website. Is there a reason the application isn't visible on the website as this hinders the public's ability to object.

I would like to log an objection to this application.

1 - Prevention of crime and disorder.

There has been increasing antisocial behaviour around the top of main street where the shop is located, criminal damage has occurred to some of the businesses here with signage damaged and businesses defaced which has been reported to the police. The shop selling alcohol will attract and increase this anti social behaviour to this area.

There are several shops on the same road within a few minutes walking distance which sell alcohol, all on the same road in the small town centre. This includes a Tesco, a Co-op, a Nissa, a bargain booze and a shop specifically dedicated to alcohol called Tippl. There would be no benefit to the local area to have another alcohol outlet. In addition to this there are several bars, pubs and restaurants which further serve alcohol.

There is no parking at the top of the road where this shop is, the corner shop has already closed due to a lack of customers. If the shop starts to deliver alcohol which would be the only profitable avenue, then there would be nowhere for the delivery driver to park and the town center already has a lack of parking, please see the objections on the planning application for a takeaway for the same property which has since been withdrawn after objection from the local Councillor Mike Dobson and the local planning association. It has been raised that this is a busy junction and is a protected junction, increasing the already congested area of this road is dangerous and would lead to illegal parking further putting the public in danger.

Please take these points into consideration.
