To Whom It May Concern,

Regarding the application with reference above:

I am a resident of the local area [REDACTED]. I would like to object to the extension of activity at Chevin Country Park Hotel for the following reasons:

1. The primary functions of the hotel could still be carried out under existing licensing arrangements indicating that no change is essential for the business to continue. The change of the level of impact on the surrounding area of any extension to activity may be unclear but it is reasonable to suggest that increased activity would have a negative impact in terms of noise and traffic late at night.
2. Current activity at the hotel already has an impact in terms of generating noise late in the evenings (for example when weddings are taking place); although the area in which the hotel is located is rural, there are local neighbours (including myself) who are impacted by current noise levels and any extension to activity is likely to increase such noise. I note that the application makes reference to activity being contained to 'indoors,' though the hotel has a large outdoor space and loud music is often heard clearly under current arrangements.
3. Increased noise levels may negatively impact the local natural environment (e.g. nocturnal species such as roosting bats and barn owls; the Council itself is aware that such species are resident in the surrounding woodland).

I am not opposed to maintaining the status quo to ensure the business continues successfully. However I would not be in favour of an extension to activities for the reasons above - in my opinion, the remote setting of the hotel should not be a reason why an extension is granted as there would be a negative impact on the local area which should not be overlooked.

I would like to object to the proposal to extend licencing and playing of music until 2am at The Chevin Country House Hotel.

We live approx 1/2 mile away as the crow flies and have [REDACTED]

[REDACTED]. We receive 2 new sets of guests approx every 3 days. Our guests come here for peace and relaxation. The rule we have placed on these lodges are for quiet inside and out after 10pm, to respect our 3 sets of neighbours wishes and to allow all guests the peace of the countryside . Last summer the noise coming down the hill was very loud, music and people shouting over the music, we could hear full conversations until the music was turned off at midnight. I can only presume the hotel had all of the windows and doors open with the guests outside.

We cannot expect our guests to observe quiet time after 10pm if there is a lot of noise coming from the Chevin Country House Hotel until 2 am. We also do not want to remove the rule of quiet time after 10pm at our lodges as this would disturb our neighbours and other guests.

If this extension to the license is granted it will have a detrimental affect on our business with negative reviews and a reduction in bookings.
