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Dear Carmel,

I hope you are well and having a good time. Forgive me for my previous mistakes. I was really nervous and stressed to approach you by email and I hope this email doesn't upset you. I would like to give you some information regarding the business. I was honestly not aware and I was not told by authorities or yourself that I could not work or be involved in Madison bar & grill, otherwise I would not waste your time and my money there because I used the bounce back loan £20,000 Lloyds bank +£50,000 starling bank to improve the business and the building.

Unfortunately after [REDACTED] passed away, we lost our supervisor and director which made things difficult and [REDACTED] is ill and unable to communicate with you. I fired [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] because they were not following the rules. We have new kitchen equipment, including a pizza oven, a grill for burgers, a police drug box is mounted on the wall and other equipment is going to be set up.

In this situation I am helpless and beg for your mercy, as this business is my livelihood. I need your help and advice, if you could give me an opportunity to meet with you please and give me some pointers on what I can do and what I should not do to meet the licensing requirements. Even I can set up the business ready to sell and come out of this situation before you revoke the license.

I hope I can meet you soon for some advice. Everything I wrote is honest, I hope you can understand the situation and help me.
