(Set out all necessary decisions to be taken by the decision taker including decisions in relation to exempt information, exemption from call in etc.)  The Director of Communities, Housing and Environment has approved the decision to accept the grant allocation from DLUHC, subject to their approval and award funding to the value of £4,045,811 to a number of organisations to enhance the support to people who are rough sleeping or at risk of rough sleeping and/ or homelessness in Leeds up to 2025.		
	A brief statement of the reasons for the decision (Include any significant financial, procurement, legal or equalities implications, having consulted with Finance, PACS, Legal, HR and Equality colleagues as appropriate)  1.1 The grant funding directly contributes to the Best Council Plan's overarching vision of tackling poverty and reducing inequalities. It addresses the Best Council Plan's priority of keeping people safe from harm, protecting the most vulnerable, minimising homelessness and reducing health inequalities.  1.2 RSI has been used for a number of years to provide an annual grant to LCC to enable specialist support and accommodation to be provided for people who are homeless and/or rough sleeping. The organisations to be allocated grant funding are considered the best
