He gives them to other lonely souls, people suffering mentally, and anyone in need of a kind word from a stranger.</p>	PG	<p>No concerns with the applicant's recommended PG rating.</p>
<b>Displaced</b>	<p>Displaced is the cinematic reimagining of Akeim Toussaint Buck's one-man dance theatre show: 'Windows of Displacement'. Co-Directed and Produced by Ashley Karrell, the film continues the exploration of themes such as: displacement, race, culture and imperialism. Focussing more on the African Diaspora via the settings of the inner-city community.</p> <p>Taking aspects of the live work and re-contextualising them in real-life spaces that support in amplifying this feeling of displacement. Giving the viewer a fraction of the feeling of being displaced people. Visually captivating with striking imagery and virtuoso dance, 'Displaced' takes the viewer on a journey calling for reflection and global change.</p>	PG	<p>No concerns with a PG rating. There are a couple of instances where rape is mentioned but this is in a historical context.</p>
<b>American Marriage</b>	<p>Leonardo, an Italian immigrant who lives in New York, marries a Latina woman, Nikki, to obtain the American green card. Through the comedy of it all Nikki and Leo fall in love for real, but it looks like someone will have the last laugh.</p>	PG	<p>No concerns with a PG rating. One instance of bad language in Italian with subtitles but not aggressive and suitable for PG.</p>

<b>Covid Love</b>	A satirical and practical view of dating during the international lockdowns.	<b>PG</b>	No Concerns with a PG. Mild sexual innuendo and one direct humorous reference to sex in a mild way.
<b>Shear</b>	Yasmin, an impressionable South Asian teen, finds herself trapped between her strict, traditional family and the man she is in love with. One night, when Yasmin sneaks out to a party, she inadvertently starts a chain of events that changes her life forever.	<b>PG/12</b>	Some bad language, scenes of moderate discrimination, drinking and references to sex. All within a context suitable for a 12 rating. The officer would have no concerns with a 12A rating.
<b>Mother Said</b>	Directed by Joseph Derrick and Samuel Elphick (Leeds) When things seem bleakest, a mother's words can inspire a journey to a brighter future.	<b>PG</b>	No content that causes any concern for a PG rating. Would be suitable for a U classification.
<b>Barry the Beekeeper</b>	Elle, 78 claims that she is completely Swedish and has grown a resentment for Sami people even though she speaks Sami and grew up in the Mountains in Lapland. Under pressure from her son, she reluctantly returns north for her sister's funeral.	<b>PG</b>	No content that causes any concern.
<b>Non E Una Bufala</b>	A pizza delivery guy gets quizzed by a passionate Italian over the originality of the food he is serving. Is it really buffalo mozzarella?	<b>PG</b>	The officer recommends members view this feature as they consider that some areas of this video regarding dangerous behaviour and discrimination may be outside of the guidelines for a PG and more akin to a 12.
<b>Young Phoenix</b>	Three young adults create a bond whilst striving to promote mental well-being among their peers, sharing their experiences with anxiety, depression and addiction. The aim of this picture is de-stigmatization, with poignant metaphoric visuals and poetic narrative uniquely portraying the symptoms and emotions of these social experience. On a journey to the light at the end of the tunnel the group share their darkest moments – highlighting the vitality of communication in (male) mental health and illustrating support is closer than you think.	<b>PG</b>	There is no content that causes concern for a PG rating.
