	requirement for new highways assets by LCC. These include upgraded traffic					
	signal units, ancillary traffic detection and monitoring equipment associated with the traffic signals, additional areas of hard (carriageway and footway surfacing) and					
	soft (embankment, grassed verge) landscaping, additional drainage connections					
	and pipework and buried water attenuation units. A complete schedule of these
