Dear Bob,

Thank you for your letter attempting to allay my fears about the above Licence application.

Unfortunately, you seem to have misunderstood the reasons that Headingley needs the protection of the Cumulative Impact Policy to help prevent the increase in both size and number of alcohol outlets.

Prior to the CIP, every applicant was able to offer the defence that their premises would be well managed and that they could not be held responsible for the anti-social behaviour that existed before they even started trading!

Fortunately, the Council's Licensing panel saw through the "Catch22" of that defence and established that (in the absence of exceptional reasons for support) all new applications should be rejected.

The Leeds Govt public access website will not allow me to see the details of the application; But I note that it is not for a restaurant but "a family style food outlet with alcohol". The devil could be in the detail. Regardless of any good intentions at the outset, the Premises Licence will outlast any proposed management style.

I cannot see how this application will add to the amenity for the residents of Headingley or lead to any decrease the high level of anti-social behaviour currently suffered due to the significant number of alcohol outlets in the area.
