A brief statement of the reasons for the decision

To upgrade the pedestrian crossing on Kirkstall Road in front of the site to a Toucan crossing, including widening the central path;

To the existing footway along the whole of the site frontage to 4.0m. The footway behind bus stop number 11762 in front of the site will be widened to 5.0m. The additional land will then be dedicated to highways;

To form two vehicular access points on Kirkstall Road to serve the development;

To remove all redundant access points along the site frontage and reinstate full-height footway;

To revoke the existing Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) on Kirkstall Road up to Willow Road / Viaduct Road junction and provide a new TRO to 'No Loading at Any Time' '; and

To carry out the associated resurfacing, road marking / signage alterations and street lighting associated with the above in accordance with the standards. The TRO will be implemented following authorisation of the City Solicitor to advertise a Draft TRO; and if no valid objections are received, to make, seal and implement the TROs as advertised.
