

Leeds Markets Shipping Container Consultation

The tables and charts below show responses from Ward Members/Councillors only. As there were only 10 responses made by our members, figures are shown as values rather than percentages.

Of the 10 Members, only one stated that they do not visit the market to eat or shop. Of the 9 who do visit the market, the frequency of visits is shown below.

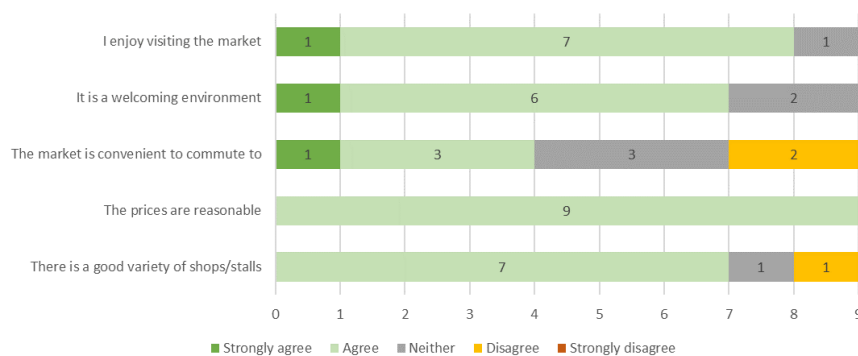

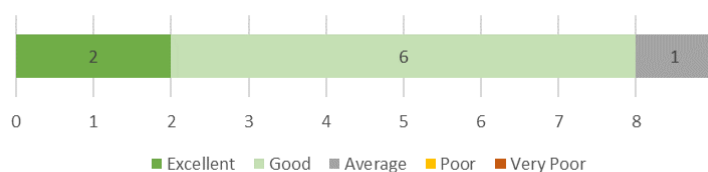
Experience at the market

The following chart shows Members' sentiments towards 5 statements relating to their experience at the markets.



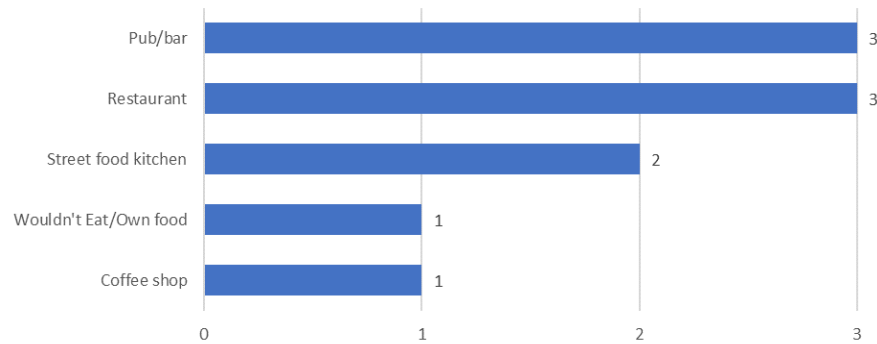
Overall experience at the market

When asked why they would eat at a specific location, the following comments were made:

- Atmosphere Good Food & Choice

- Price is not too high and warm, comfortable.
- I go to Leeds market regularly as a carer. It's an excellent environment to take people with dementia.
- Its comfortable and its good food.
- Convenience

Other shipping container sites

Of the 10 Members who responded, 6 stated that they have previously visited a shipping container site, and 4 stated they had not.

Would you visit the shipping container site?

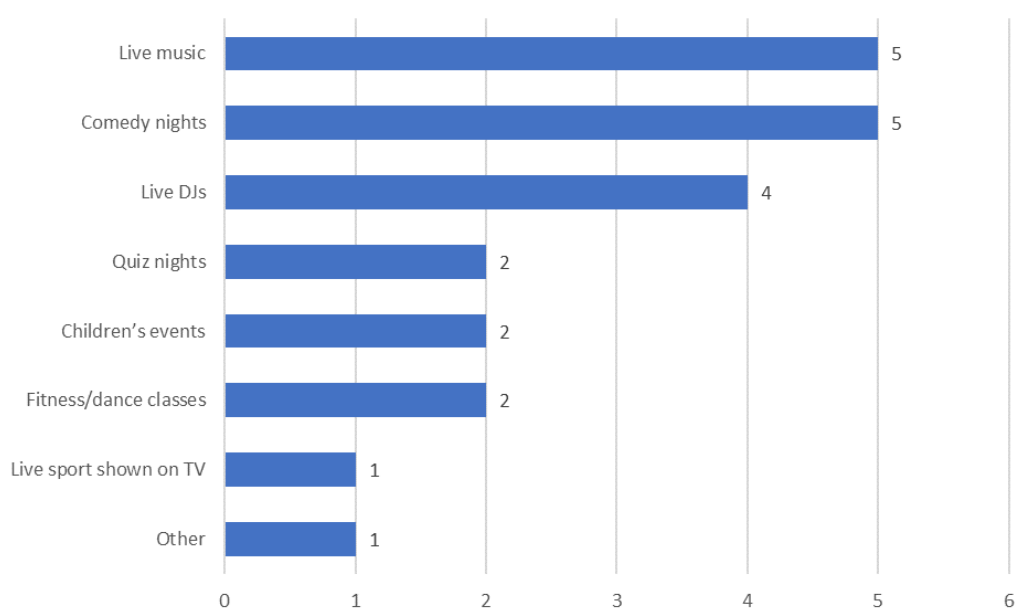
