(Set out all necessary decisions to be taken by the decision taker including decisions in relation to exempt information, exemption from call-in etc.)</p> <p>The Director of Communities, Housing and Environment approved acceptance of £304,000 from the Department for Levelling Up, Housing and Communities for continuation of the Accommodation for Ex Offenders (AfEO) programme in Leeds for the period 1st April 2023 to 31st March 2025. The Director approved the allocation of grant funding as follows:- £80,000 per annum for two staff to BARCA and £72,000 per annum to Housing Options to support the scheme and for landlord costs.</p>		
	<p>A brief statement of the reasons for the decision (Include any significant financial, procurement, legal or equalities implications, having consulted with Finance, PACS, Legal, HR and Equality colleagues as appropriate)</p> <p>Approval required to enable continuation of the programme which has been in operation since November 2021 in partnership with third sector support providers and Housing Options to identify accommodation and support for people leaving prison.</p>
