Scheme 1: General Refurbishment - £1,200,000.

Scheme 2: Telecommunications Infrastructure - £800,000.

Telecommunications infrastructure upgrades include additions to the existing fibre network. This will be largely focused on the A64 between Torre Road and Crossgates Road and the Savins Mill section of network between Wyther Lane and the A65. Works will also be undertaken to connect various equipment adjacent to existing fibre infrastructure installed as part of previous work.

This scheme will also include the upgrade of wireless telecommunications infrastructure that uses the fibre network and other third-party telecoms circuits being delivered by LCC IDS. Exact locations are not included here due to flexibility in the LCC IDS programme.

Scheme 3: Network Performance - £113,734.

A junction improvement to improve operation, as well as introduction of bus priority will be delivered at the A63/Lidgett Lane site.

Bus priority will continue to be implemented across the network as junctions are being brought online as a result of the telecommunications infrastructure element of work.

Various fixed-time plan optimisation around areas affected by CCP delivery will continue to be undertaken. In addition to works in the City Centre, in-depth reviews of signal operation in the following two areas will be undertaken:

- the vicinity of the retail park adjacent to Selby Road and Stile Hill Way
- the vicinity of the Savins Mill Way retail park between Wyther Lane and A65
