Good afternoon,

I email you with regards to the subject bar application you have recently made to Leeds City Council, which I am dealing with on behalf of West Yorkshire Police.

The police in Leeds have no outright objections to this application, but would wish to make a coupe of amendments, with regards to the "steps" you have offered at section M of the application form and particularly at box b).

To promote the four licensing objectives, West Yorkshire Police would ask you to-

- 1. agree to the <u>alternative</u> wording with regards to CCTV, to read as follows-
 - A suitable closed-circuit television (CCTV) system shall be in operation whilst members of the public are in attendance.
 - The CCTV system shall record images to cover all areas of the licensed site to which the public have access (save for toilets/showers/changing areas).
 - All entry and exit points will be covered enabling frontal identification of every person entering in any light condition.
 - At least one member of staff shall be on duty at the premises who can operate the system and download recorded images.
 - These images will be downloaded and provided immediately, or where this is not
 possible as soon as practicable, on request to an officer of a Responsible
 Authority.
 - The CCTV system shall be capable of retaining images for a minimum of 31 days, will be of good quality and will contain the correct time and date stamp

information.

• The CCTV system and images will be kept in a secure environment to which members of the public will not be permitted access.

&

- 2. agree to an additional condition to read as follow-
 - The display of alcohol shall be in a designated area of the premises which is capable of being supervised from the counter area.

In relation to both conditions, they are taken from a recently updated official document of Leeds City Council (attached), and used in conjunction with all responsible authorities in Leeds, including West Yorkshire Police.

The idea of the document being to 'standardise' the wording, where certain conditions are appropriate.

Theft of alcohol products are regularly a major contributory factor, when police computer systems are scrutinised for operating premises of this description.

With regards to the CCTV condition specifically and apart from the above, the retention of images for 31 days as opposed to 28 days, is still the period shown on the Home Office / ACPO website for CCTV guidance.

In addition to this, for the last Tesco premises issued in Leeds – at Portland Crescent (PREM/04666) – and for a One Stop Store in Allerton Bywater processed in 2016 also in Leeds – PREM/03869 – 31 days is shown on both licences, with regards to CCTV images being retained.

If you are agreeable to the above amendments, please reply to that effect, and I shall then conclude matters with Leeds City Council as far as West Yorkshire Police are concerned.

I look forward to your reply in due course, but preferably before 18th July 2023.
