As ward Councillors we are writing to object to the application in its current form specifically the request to sell alcohol on and off the premises until 3am on a Friday and Saturday night. For us to support to the application we would ask that 11pm would be the latest alcohol sales be permitted.

Railway Street is in a predominantly residential area, close to Saxton Gardens which houses a significant number of older residents. We are concerned that opening a very late-night venue in this location will inevitably lead to increased alcohol related noise nuisance and public disorder.
