On 16<sup>th</sup> June a joint operation was executed in Harehills aimed at off licences selling illicit tobacco and non-duty paid alcohol.

The operation was in collaboration with HMRC, Trading Standards, West Yorkshire Police and Leeds City Council Licensing.

During the visit to Harehills Maxi Foods, Trading Standards found a vehicle parked at the back of the shop as close to the door as possible without fully blocking the pavement. The door to the vehicle was open as was the back door to Harehills Maxi Foods creating easy access from one to the other. Within the van Trading Standards found 3,017 packets of cigarettes, which they have determined to be a mix of counterfeit and smuggled goods.

The sale of smuggled goods is a criminal offence which must be taken especially seriously given the fact that Harehills Maxi Foods currently holds a premises licence. Harehills Maxi Foods are not promoting the licensing objectives and in fact are supporting serious and organised crime by being involved in the smuggling of goods to the UK.

Further to that, during the visit my colleague from Entertainment Licensing conducted an inspection under the licensing act. The store was found to be in breach of its licence condition relating to CCTV recording for 31 days.
