Decision details³:	<p>a) The Director of Communities, Housing and Environment has approved the recommendation to accept the grant funding of £270,853 from DLUHC for the RSAP Programme Round 2 and 4 for 2024-25.</p> <p>b) The Director of Communities, Housing and Environment has approved an award of up to £145,819 as a grant to St George's Crypt for 3 Housing Support Workers for 2024-25 across the Clarion Service and Don Robbins House (RSAP 2).</p> <p>c) The Director of Communities, Housing and Environment has approved an award of up to £125,034 as a grant to Together Women for 2024-2025 for 2 Support Workers and operating costs at the Somewhere Safe to Live service (RSAP 4)</p> <p>d) The Director of Communities, Housing and Environment has approved an award of up to £80,000 Rough Sleeping Initiative (RSI) Funding for a Specialist Psychologist input to Leeds and York Partnership NHS Foundation Trust for the period 1st July 2023 to 31st March 2025. The organisations to be allocated grant funding are considered the best placed to meet these clients' needs and have been involved in bidding for the RSAP funds and in the Street Support Partnership.</p>
