# The Marmot City - Fairer Leeds programme

### **Purpose of report**

1. To update elected members on the Marmot City – Fairer Leeds programme.

#### Main issues

- 2. In January 2023, Leeds Health and Wellbeing Board made a commitment that Leeds would become a 'Marmot place'. In April 2023, a formal two-year partnership began with the Institute of Health Equity (IHE) led by Professor Sir Michael Marmot.
- 3. In the first year, the aim of the Marmot City Fairer Leeds programme has been to enable the city to better understand how to maximise opportunities to address health inequalities and to 'add value' and act as a catalyst for further action in two key areas 0-5 years and housing.
- 4. This item provides an update on the programme at the end of Year one. It invites reflection on early findings/progress and to how the recommendations and interim findings from the IHE can support action at a local or neighbourhood level.
