

APPENDIX B

All Four Licensing Objectives

1. The Premises Licence Holder shall ensure that adequate supervision of the premises is maintained at all times during the carrying out of licensable activities and that any staff are trained in ensuring compliance with the licensing objectives at all times.
2. A Personal Licence Holder shall be present on the premises when licensable activities are taking place.
3. A CCTV System shall be installed at the premises, be maintained in good working order and used at all times the premises remain open to the public for licensable activities. Any CCTV footage shall be kept for at least 28 days and be available to the Licensing Authority or a Responsible Authority on request.

The Prevention Of Crime And Disorder

4. The Premises Licence Holder shall at all times maintain a “zero tolerance” policy with regard to illegal drugs (including appropriate staff training in detection and prevention).
5. The Premises Licence Holder will ensure close liaison with other licensees in the area and will co-operate with any local “Pub Watch” schemes or similar schemes being promoted by West Yorkshire Police or other local Licensees.
6. All external and internal security lighting shall be maintained in good working order and used, where appropriate, at all times the premises remain open to the public.

Public Safety

7. All emergency lighting; fire fighting equipment and first aid facilities shall be maintained in good working order and all staff (including temporary staff) adequately trained in their use and about the evacuation procedures for the premises.

The Prevention Of Public Nuisance

8. Staff shall be trained in efficient methods for ensuring customers leave the premises in a quiet and orderly fashion.
9. Notices shall be displayed in prominent positions near exits reminding patrons to leave in a quiet and orderly manner.
10. The Premises Licence Holder shall maintain links with local private hire companies and make available inside the premises a public phone and telephone numbers for private hire cars, in order to encourage drivers not to use their horns late at night and the speedy movement away of customers leaving the premises.
11. The Premises Licence Holder shall ensure that the kitchen extraction system is maintained in good and effective working order in order to avoid nuisance from smells and noise to neighbouring properties.
12. The Premises Licence Holder shall ensure that security and other external lighting used are maintained in such a position so as to avoid light pollution to nearby residents.
13. The Premises Licence Holder shall ensure that staff monitor, on a regular basis, noise emanating from the premises from regulated entertainment to ensure that neighbouring residents are not disturbed.
14. The premises licence holder shall ensure that the external areas of the premises are kept clear of litter and refuse.

The Protection Of Children From Harm

15. Children under 16 years old shall only be allowed access into the premises when accompanied by an adult.
16. An appropriate proof of age policy, incorporating the principles of the “Challenge 21” Campaign shall be implemented; incorporating measures to ensure that any patron wishing to purchase alcohol who may reasonably appear to be under 21 years of age are asked to prove that they are at least 18 years old by displaying evidence of their identity and age in the form of a valid UK passport, new style driving licence displaying their photograph or PASS identification.
