

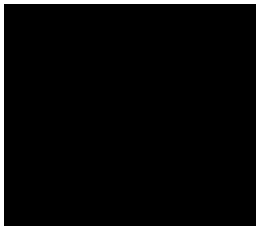

The grounds of the representation is based on the following:

1. THE SHOP IS OPPOSITE CALVERLEY PARK AND WITH A BENCH DIRECTLY OUTSIDE; BOTH WILL ENCOURAGE ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION IN A PUBLIC SPACE. THIS WILL INCREASE RISK OF ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR AND STREET DRINKING.
2. THERE IS A PEDESTRIAN CROSSING AND ZIG-ZAGS DIRECTLY OUTSIDE THE SHOP. THIS WILL ENCOURAGE ILLEGAL PARKING, WITH RISK TO PEDESTRIANS USING THE CROSSING.
3. THIS MAY INCREASE DELIVERY VEHICLES WITH SIMILAR CONSEQUENCES.
4. RISK OF INCREASING PUBLIC NUISANCE THROUGH NOISE, CONGREGATION OF PEOPLE (ESPECIALLY YOUNGER PEOPLE), PLUS CAR DOORS SLAMMING (LATER AT

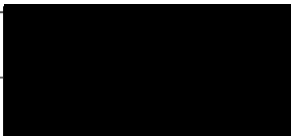

- 5. RISK OF INCREASING LITTER AND CUMULATIVE EFFECT IN THE WIDER NEIGHBOURHOOD.
- 6. ADDITIONAL USE IS NOT COMPATIBLE WITH AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF CALVERLEY CONSERVATION AREA.
- 7. PERIOD BETWEEN 07-15 AND 07-45 IS PEAK TIME FOR CHILDREN GATHERING OPPOSITE (OUTSIDE PARK) WAITING FOR SCHOOL BUSES.
- 8. PREVIOUS SHOP OPENING TIMES BELIEVED TO BE 07-00 TO 19-00 (OR LESS), 12 HOURS A DAY. CURRENT HOURS APPEAR INCREASED TO 07-00 TO 23-00, 16 HOURS A DAY, WHICH WOULD BE AN INCREASE OF 33%, WITH PROPORTIONATE INCREASE IN RISK OF NUISANCE BEYOND PREVIOUS OPENING HOURS, PARTICULARLY AS THIS WOULD BE BEYOND "NORMAL" OPENING HOURS
