Hi Sam - please find attached a word document with the full list of films we're planning to show at Leeds International Film Festival 2024 that don't have a BBFC Certificate and we would like to request as 18. This is because our audience is almost exclusively over 18 anyway. Please note that most of these films would not have an 18 certificate if they were rated by the BBFC, they would be 15 or lower. Even the adult films such as the horror films, which would get 18 ratings for their content, have nothing extreme or problematic compared with regular film releases. I can confirm there are definitely no R18 films in the programme, none of the films listed include any content which the BBFC would consider inappropriate for a regular 18 certificate.
